Application Form

All exchange students are required to submit an application form along with other supporting documents. Below are some instructions:

1. Personal Information

Full Name in English: As shown on your passport

<u>Full Name in Chinese</u>: You need to have a Chinese name for official use during your stay in Taiwan and your Chinese name should remain consistent once chosen. There are two ways to fill in this item.

- A. If you already have a Chinese name, please fill it in. (You can handwrite your Chinese name after printing out the form if your computer does not support Chinese language.)
- B. If you do not have a Chinese name and will accept an alternative name given by College of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, please tick "accept a given Chinese name". We will give you a Chinese name based on the pronunciation of your original name.

Date of Birth: As shown on your passport.

<u>Nationality</u>: Please provide all the countries of which you are holding a passport. We do not accept students with Taiwanese nationality. However, dual citizenships holders are NOT restricted to this regulation, but a copy of non-Taiwan passport still has to be provided.

2. Contact Information:

Please make sure the contact information you provide is correct to avoid missing any important information we send to you.

3. Emergency Contact

Please provide information on someone we can contact in case of an emergency.

4. Home School Information

You must indicate clearly the name of your department/program, school, and level of study. It is also required to indicate which year is the current year of your study at your home school.

5. Study at NTU College of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science

Level of Study: It should correspond with your level of study at home school.

<u>Period of Study</u>: It is important that you read carefully the three alternatives for the duration of study at NTU and choose ONLY ONE you wish to apply for. Once you have submitted your application, you cannot change the duration of your study.

<u>Department/Program of Study</u>: You MUST fill in along with the name of a department or institute at NTU College of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science relevant to your study following the Academic List below. ③ A Copy of Health and Accident Insurance Proof

You are required to purchase your own insurance in your home country before entering Taiwan.

Please provide a proof of accident and medical insurance which worth a minimum of TWD 1,000,000 (approx. USD 33,000) for each. The accident and medical insurance should cover for the entire exchange period.

International students residing in Taiwan for more than six months are eligible to participate in the Taiwanese National Health Insurance (NHI) program, but the NHI reimbursement is very limited and can only serve as an additional insurance in addition to your home country insurance.

® NTU Incoming Exchange / Visiting Students Health Exam Form

In order to understand the general health condition of coming students, and to meet the regulations of National Taiwan University, all students should receive a health exam by a qualified physician.

For convenience, we suggest you take the health exam abroad, as long as all items are completed and the examination form includes the doctor's signature and stamp of the hospital or clinic (for certification), and is no longer than 3 month old.

Before you arrive in NTU, please first send the scan copy of your health exam form to the EECS international coordinator (Susan Mou:shiuanmou@ntu.edu.tw). And the original one shall be hand in while you doing the registration at NTU. Please note that the registration procedure is not complete if the new student does not have her/his health exam form completed.
